SPECIAL MEETING

April 30, 2025

The St. Mary Levee District (“SMLD”) met on this date with President William Hidalgo Sr., presiding and the following board members present: Mike Ortiz, Carla Davis, Kenny Arceneaux, Mike Thomason, Andrew Mancuso, Kenny Arceneaux, and with Will Terry and J.P. Hebert absent.

Also present: Tim Matte, Executive Director; Michael Brocato, Operations Manager; William Bourgeois; and members of the public.

Mr. Ortiz motioned to award a contract to Gray Construction Corporation for the installation of a weir on the LA 70 canal. After a second by Mr. Mancuso, the motion was carried unanimously.

Mr. Mancuso motioned to award a contract for procurement of pumps, engines and related equipment for Pump Station 4. Bids we received on April 28, 2025, and GIS, project engineer, recommends the award of the contract to Associated Pump & Supply, Inc. After a second by Mr. Arceneaux, the motion was carried unanimously.

Mr. Mancuso motioned to authorize Mr. Hidalgo to award a contract on the waterline relocation and clearing of Pump Station 9 input canal as part of the CPRA’s TE 168 project. Southern Constructors submitted the lowest price on their proposal. After a second by Mr. Thomason, the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Hidalgo asked for further comments and did not receive any. Mr. Arceneaux moved for adjournment, which was seconded by Mr. Mancuso and was carried unanimously.
